## **Esthetics Program Admission Requirements**

### **1. GRADE 12 CANADIAN HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR EQUIVALENT**

**OR**

#### **MATURE STUDENTS**

- A mature student is as defined by the Ministry regulating Private Career Colleges in your province.
- Entrance testing is required for all students not possessing a Grade 12 diploma at the general level of better. All students applying as mature students are to be tested to establish literacy in the English language. A third party entrance test that is normed and referenced to Grade 12 standards is required. Please follow the regulations in your province regarding mature student testing.

**OR**

#### **FOREIGN STUDENTS**

- All foreign credentials must be translated into English and assessed as equivalent to Grade 12 Canadian High School diploma.
- All foreign students must undergo entrance testing to establish literacy in the English language. A third party entrance test that is normed and referenced to Grade 12 standards is required.

### **2. FLUENCY IN ENGLISH**

- Demonstrated skill in communication and comprehension sufficient to meet the demands of the program as assessed by personal interview and student questionnaire or literacy examination.
- All students applying as mature students or foreign students must undergo third party entrance testing to establish literacy in the English language equivalent to Grade 12 Canadian High School.

Specifically, students must be able to:

- Read textbooks and other materials as part of the program
- Understand and participate in the classroom (lectures, class presentations, discussions, etc.)
- Write class assignments and tests

### **3. FITNESS TO COMPLETE THE CLINICAL PLACEMENT**

- Immunization Status must be up to date
  - Students must be free of communicable disease
  - Hepatitis B immunization is required
- Good General Health

### **4. POLICE CHECK (CLEARANCE) OF CRIMINAL RECORD**

- Must be produced within 30 days of starting school. Individuals who have a criminal record are not able to participate in the clinical placement and therefore will not be able to graduate from the program.
